Revised Personal Statement

Your task

At the beginning of Junior Trader+, you wrote a short personal statement explaining your interest in finance, investment and the programme.

Now return to it.

Your final task is to rewrite that statement in light of what you have learned and experienced.

Before you start

Read your original statement again before writing anything.

Consider:

- Has your understanding of finance or investment changed?
- Can you now explain your interests more precisely?
- Which parts of the programme genuinely influenced your thinking?
- What have you learned about your own strengths or interests?
- Has the programme changed what you want to explore next?
- Can you now support your claims with evidence rather than simply saying you are interested in finance?

What to submit

Write a revised statement of approximately 150–200 words.

This should not simply be a more polished version of your original statement. We want to see development.

Be specific. Rather than trying to sound impressive, demonstrate what you have learned through the ideas, examples and experiences you choose to discuss.

Your original and revised statements will be considered alongside your work throughout the programme as part of your personalised feedback.

The question at the end should be: what can you now say about yourself that you could not have said when you started Junior Trader+?
